The Colorado-Speech-Hearing Foundation scholarship is a \$500.00 scholarship offered to eligible graduate students.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student and must be candidates for a Master's degree, PhD. or AuD. in the fields of speech/language pathology, audiology and/or speech and hearing science at a graduate school in Colorado. Applicants must be residents in the state of Colorado and show evidence of outstanding ability and application of learning in clinical and/or research endeavors.

APPLICATION: The completed application form must be accompanied by the following supporting documents.

1. Unofficial graduate transcript
2. Letter of recommendation from advisor or department chairperson including documentation of the applicant's graduate status
3. Evidence of Colorado residency (Colorado driver's license, voter registration)
4. Two reference letters (see attached guideline)
5. A brief essay, not to exceed 300 words, written by the applicant which indicates their interest in and plans for a career in speech-language pathology or audiology.
6. Resume
7. Enclose three copies of the essay and scholarship application form.
